 - i. \$5,884.73
 - b. Potential Impact of COVID-19
 - i. Biggest issue would be the fewer in-person conferences.

- 5. 2020-2021 Budget Discussion Report Card (Ehrhorn/Karamshin)
 - a. Conferences
 - i. Geotech Conference
 - Currently conference budget/incomes are guesses
 - City/county might shut down in person conferences
 - Short course could be included as part of bigger conference
 - ii. Transportation Conference
 - Assuming numbers from last year

- Opportunity to push conference into summer
- Gardels to update with info from the geotech overview
- iii. Structural Conference
 - Hosted by SEAON, in September. Was canceled. No conversations about virtual.
 - 2021 not currently addressed. Conversations typically start in February
- b. Monthly Meetings and Annual Meeting
 - i. Annual Meeting
 - Numbers based on 2019
 - Set up virtual option with in person board
 - 2020 was cancelled and was refunded
 - ii. Structural
 - Structural meeting usually at a loss, many student attendees (free).
 Proposed numbers based on 2019
 - iii. Construction
 - Numbers from last year, might update.
 - Meeting is generally in October for this fiscal year
 - iv. Management
 - Continue typical venue at restaurant, or switch to social distance accommodating
 - Should still offer virtual as well could also increase turnout
 - v. Water
 - Cost for non-members went down, but otherwise based on 2020
 - vi. Geotech
 - Meeting to be held as planned, night before conference. No cocktail hour likely.
 - Option to spread tables out to keep social distancing that way
 - Opportunity to do virtual attendance as well
 - vii. Environmental
 - Numbers similar to last year
 - viii. Transportation
- c. Events
 - YMG (Podany & Company)
 - Smaller events, \$500/event. No income per event
 - Ideas include a 2-man golf scramble. Potential for annual event. \$1900 all expenses, 36 max. idea for spring
 - ii. Future City
- Did change some from last year no space rentals
- No in person events but will still be giving out awards
- iii. Trust Bustin'
- Venue and tickets removed, but other expenses remain the same
- iv. Career Fairs
- Not sure how that will work with schools.
- Keep budgeted
- v. Concrete Canoe & Steel Bridge
 - \$1200/school, half for each activity
 - Talked last year about bumping to \$1500/school
 - Steel bridge is officially not a part of ASCE anymore
 - Students put together a budget for \$1920 we want to be supportive but not the only funding source so we usually

push back

- vi. E-Week/Outreach
 - Younger audience, gave away STEM kit, more money than the previous year but well worth it
 - Probably won't spend as much this year
- d. General
 - i. Grants
 - ii. Office Items
 - Engineering round table donation
 - Our serction has done this in the past but not the last couple years
 - Usually promoted more when ASCE is one of the national chairs
 - iii. Scholarships
 - Transportation and Geotech scholarships have both stayed the same for this year's budget
 - Separate from Budget, we need to pay in
 - Third scholarship that is fully funded

 - Stamm will look through documentations to find more information
 - iv. Newsletter
 - Same numbers as last year
 - Lack of responses
 - Comment about increasing price of advertisements
 - v. Lobbying
 - We pay \$3750 to a lobbyist every year. They advocate for us and let us know when issues come up
 - Used to get a report every session.
 - Value in supporting lobbyists, but might need to directly request from them
 - · Konda to follow up with this item
- e. Leadership Conferences
 - i. President & Governors Forum
 - 2020 Forum was virtual event, occurred a couple weeks ago
 - Kept nearly same budget as years past
 - ii. ASCE 2020 Convention (Virtual Event)
 - End of October
 - Registration is \$295
 - iii. YMLS
 - iv. Legislative Fly-In
 - Would like to send 2 people minimum if it is hosted
 - We will know if it's being hosted after national election
 - Will most likely be a modified virtual format
 - Could push for more attendance if its virtual including a younger member
 - v. SEI Local Activities Meeting
 - October 2020 is being hosted virtually, no costs
 - 2021, assuming no COVID, SEI will subsidize some of the expenses, anything remaining will be included
